



Congratulations on successfully completing week one of online learning with your student(s)! Your teachers should have communicated with you about all the information to expect during the packet pickup this morning.




A great alternative to checking books out in the school library is Sora by OverDrive. Sora is an online app where you can access free ebooks and audiobooks from your school and local library.


Kindergarten registration has been postponed until further notice. You may still register online at the following link: https://sites.google.com/washk12.org/student-forms

In mid-March, homes across the country began receiving invitations to complete the 2020 Census.

Once the invitation arrives, you should respond for your home in one of three ways: online (https://census2020.utah.gov/), by phone, or by mail.

When you respond to the census, you'll tell the Census Bureau where you live as of April 1, 2020.
