- 1+ month into school how's it going? Masks, learning, 4 busses, etc.
  - 2 employees & 4 students out of 35,000 plus students in WCSD- cases of coronavirus
  - DVES lunches spread out over a 2 hour time period
  - Recess is only one grade level at a time
  - STEAM Explos only one grade level- exception is Lego League which has 4th and 5th grade students from the team
  - Contact tracing is in place
    - On the bus- Brandon will make sure <u>all</u> bus drivers are following this
    - In class
    - In the library
    - In the lunchroom
  - 4 Busses have been working out well- the town parents are loving it
- Letter from Brad Wilson Speaker of the House
  - Letter shared by Brandon with the council
  - We appreciate the hard work of our teachers and staff in getting the school year going well
- Review STL Plan/Budget
  - Music Teacher partially supported through Beverly Taylor grant Kirk Jones
  - Kindergarten Para to support positive behavior and learning Jasmine Tanner
  - $\circ$   $\phantom{-}.5$  FTE to help support Spanish DLI and ALP classes
    - Some of our classes schoolwide are smaller than the state FTE allows funding a full teacher for so we use these funds to pay for half of a teacher contract - Beatriz Ordas
      - This allows us to free up other WCSD Literacy funds for Reading Paraprofessionals
- TSSA Plan Review
  - School data used to develop learning goals for our students
  - Students will complete a full section of Rocket Math to improve Math fact fluency
  - STEAM Explo classes each Friday for students in grades 1-5
  - Improve Literacy of students by providing Reading Paraprofessionals for smaller groups
  - Improve Technology and Future Ready skills of students by providing one-to-one chromebooks
    - This helps with digital safety
    - Also helps with sanitation concerns
- PL Grant
  - Professional Learning grants written for our school
    - STEM Action Center
    - Digital Teaching and Learning Grant through WCSD
- Roundabout Traffic Flow Changing again
  - Cement poured right before school because of weather concerns/WCSD calendaring
    - New pick up/drop off zones and traffic patterns were created to avoid cars on the cement
  - No cars allowed because there are no barriers to keep vehicles from going up to the front of the school.
  - Permanent barriers and cones are on backorder, so when they are put in, the traffic pattern will change again

- For now- students and parents will be trained to use the West crosswalk
  - Bike racks have already been moved to the West side of the driveway
  - Crossing guard will help students cross at the top of the driveway and also across Diamond Valley Drive
- Fence Around Perimeter of School
  - When the mow crew slows down this Fall, they will begin installing the rest of our 6 foot fence
  - Gates are being constructed now to be installed this Fall
- Online safety Digital Citizenship Lessons
  - Each classroom teacher will give digital citizenship lessons to their students
  - Computer Lab para gives lessons as part of scheduled student computer time
  - We have had 2 issues at school with digital citizenship so far this school year and Brandon has talked to the students, parents and teachers involved
    - We are using these issues as learning opportunities for our students
- Safety doors in the front hallway
  - These have made it so that parents and visitors to the school have to check in at the office
- Money from School Trustlands comes from a formula based on student enrollment
